# Tasks:

The position is part of the EU-funded project "Holistic Approach to Addressing Systemic Food Risks in Dynamic Global Contexts" (HOLiFOOD) within a newly founded junior research group on reputation and trust building. The work explores suitable participatory methods for generating data and communication on the sustainability performance of food systems. It also deals with the potential institutionalization of such methods in the context of holistic risk analysis approaches.

In detail, the activities include

- Literature research and document analysis on (holistic) risk and sustainability analysis, including participatory risk communication and perception research
- Planning, implementation and evaluation of semi-structured interviews and online consultations with experts on the institutionalization of holistic risk analysis approaches and participatory risk communication
- Writing final reports and scientific publications


